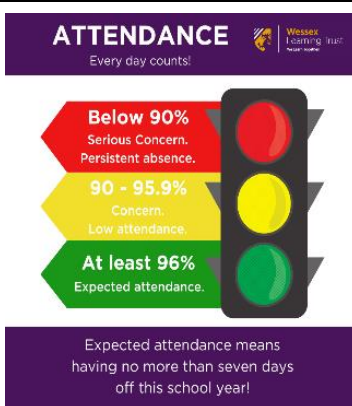
Attendance Roundup:
