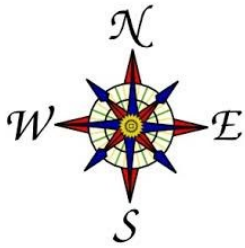

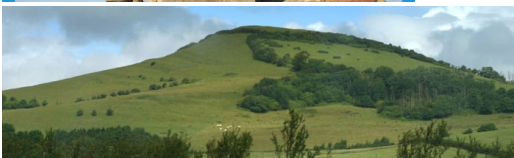
- Name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans

Vocabulary

Capital City: a city where the government of that country is based

Continent: a large area of land. There are 7 continents; Asia, North America, South America, Europe, Australasia and Antarctica.

Country: a land that is controlled by one government.

County: a region within the United Kingdom.

Map Key: information on a map that explains what the symbols mean.

Ocean: a huge body of salt water. There is one world ocean, but it is divided into 5 five main areas: the Pacific, the Atlantic, the Indian, the Arctic, and the Southern, or Antarctic.

Population: the number of people in a particular place.

Sea: a body of salt water smaller than an ocean.

Services: hospitals, schools places of worship, shops, public transport

Town: a medium sized area where people live, often with lots of services such as schools, train stations, hospitals, shopping centres and at least one place of worship

Village: a small area in the countryside where people live
