Attendance: A reminder for all please. If you are taking your child out of school during term time, even for a partial day, then you must complete a term time absence form. We have had a number of absences due to holidays or day trips where families have emailed on the day with no notice or reason given. Any absences through illness etc. need to be reported to the school office by 9.20am at the latest when registers close. Medical appointments known in advance should be supported by evidence of that appointment to the school office. We have also had an increase in families arriving between 2-3pm to collect children early without due notice or planned absence form completed. This is becoming very disruptive to learning in class and is leaving children with gaps in their knowledge. Please can we ask families to avoid collecting children early unless for emergencies.
